Sam Willoughby is an Australian former BMX cyclist. Aged just 21, and largely self-coached and managed, he won an Olympic silver medal in 2012. By 25, he was in a relationship with Alise Post – also a world ranked competitor, and Sam was near the top of his sport in world rankings. In that same year, 2016, Sam suffered a career-ending injury. During routine training he flipped from the back of his bike, injuring his spine and he has been confined to a wheel chair ever since. For many, that would be almost the end of the story.

Sam Willoughby is different. In January 2019, he 'walked' down the aisle to marry Alise, and even though he relies on a wheelchair, he is a professional BMX coach. In fact, Sam was Elise's coach when she won the 2019 World Championship Title.

How did he come so far? I'm guessing a combination of things. His wife and family were 100% there for him – rock solid and always in his corner. He met a legendary NASCAR Crew Chief, Bootie Barker, who showed him what you can do if you don't let yourself be limited. Growing up in sport, he knew that winners don't quit.

One thought I particularly liked is that he said don't be afraid to take risks. Many people fear what might happen if things go wrong. Yet he is living proof, that provided you are all in – 100% committed, you will be okay. Even if things do go wrong – you will come out the other side.

His is a great story, and one I'd recommend you listen to or read about. He is a wonderful example of gratitude, being in the moment and living fully.

We too, have much to be grateful for. We've begun the year with some fantastic new staff. We have just over 500 students who are very much enjoying the beginning of 2021, and our community is already displaying the welcome and inclusion we are so proud of.

On Friday March 12th at 9:00, we have our first whole of school liturgy. During the liturgy, we will proudly acknowledge the school leaders for 2021 and you are all very welcome to join us if you are able.

BUNDABERG DISTRICT U12 SCHOOL SPORTS TRIALS-2021

Trial information will be advised in the school's newsletter each week detailing trial information for upcoming individual and team events. Students will also be informed on Parade. Gaining selection in a Bundaberg District Team is the first step on the pathway to representing Wide Bay and Queensland. To represent Bundaberg District, students must be born 2009, 2010 & 2011 (only exceptional 10 year old students will be given permission to trial in team sports). The majority of team sport trials occur in February and March.

Please be aware of the following points:

- No student born 2008 is eligible to trial.
- Team sports are selected in an U12 category and it is very unlikely that a 10 year old student would be selected, with the exception of Rugby League. Rugby League selects in U10, U11 and U12 categories due to the contact nature of the sport.
- Bundaberg District trials are not 'have a go' trials. St Patrick's has a responsibility for sending students who we feel display high ability in the chosen sport and a high level of behaviour.
- Students wishing to trial must have a consent form issued by the school with authorisation from Mr Plumb, Ms Gollshewsky or Annette Hammermeister. Students will not be able to participate in the trials without a *Bundaberg District Primary Schools nomination form*.
- Cross Country and Athletics nominations will be made by the school after our school carnivals. Swimming & Aquathlon are the exceptions Wide Bay School Sport are responsible for the selection of these teams.

When times are submitted, they must be verified by printouts from Meet Manager and then stamped and signed by the club's secretary or record keeper. If this procedure is not followed, times will not be accepted.

NOTE: Due to COVID-19 restrictions and concerns while attending swim meets, and the cancellation of some swim meets it has been decided to extend the time frame that times can be submitted for consideration. Swimmers can now nominate times from January 2020 until 19 February 2021 rather than just the current swimming season.

Regional selections will be based on results (times) from District carnivals for 50-metre events **OR** Times recorded at a QSA sanctioned meet in a 50m pool from **January 2020** to the close of nominations on Friday 19 February 2021. These times will be considered for selection due to COVID restrictions.




The following posters have been placed throughout the school to encourage safe hygiene practices.

All classrooms have been supplied with hand sanitizer and soap. Staff will remind children about handwashing, sneezing into elbows and not touching faces.


High touch surfaces in all classes and offices within the school setting are being cleaned daily.

Welcome to the 2021 school year. A reminder to existing families and for the information of new families regarding school fees that fees are emailed by the end of week 2 every term and are payable within 14 days unless you have a payment plan in place, in which case they merely serve as a statement for your records. Upon receipt, please take time to review your invoice/statement and contact Finance Secretary Maria Davies if you have any queries or any time should you wish to setup a payment plan. Please check your junk box if think you haven't received your statement.

It is the responsibility of all parents to pay school fees when attending Catholic schools. Your contribution through school fees is essential to the continued operation of your Catholic school. Any shortfall in assessed fees for the year has to be met from the general school account which could mean less in our budget to meet our commitments. If you are having difficulty in paying school fees, please contact the finance secretary to discuss alternative arrangements.

To ensure you are being billed correctly, if you haven't already done so, please login to parent lounge to complete the Confirmation of Enrolment Form. One form per family is required and is issued in the name of the eldest child in the family. Confirmation of Enrolment Form is not only used to ensure your children a place at St Patrick's but it ensures you will receive discounts if you have more than one child at a Catholic School or College in the Diocese of Rockhampton and it also directs your payment plan selections and any concessional allowance.


