

LENT CHALLENGES

On Wednesday we marked the start of Lent with a lovely, respectful Ash Wednesday Liturgy. During the forty days of Lent we will be journeying together, preparing our hearts and our lives for the new hope that we are promised at Easter. Lent is a time of prayer a time for reflecting on the way we live our lives. During this period we take time to examine our hearts and be willing to make changes by being better people. It is a time for saying 'sorry' and asking forgiveness.

This year we have set ourselves the 'Tanks of Hope' challenge for Lent. This is a fundraising challenge which, along with the Mini Fair proceeds, will go to Project Compassion. All students have been given their Project Compassion boxes in preparation to help fill our 'Tanks of Hope' with water drops (to the value of their donations). Students are very excited about being able to help out children in countries where fresh water is a luxury and a scarcity. You can see our progress on the library notice board. We are aiming to be able to provide a community in Zimbabwe with a solar powered pump to pump water from a fresh, clean water source to their village. 
