## Principal's News

Dear Parents

We are very pleased with the way our building project is progressing. We have committed to minimising disruption during the works, and keeping people informed contributes to that goal. Below is an outline of how we plan to minimise disruptions for the rest of this term

Today completes Week 7 of our

II week term.

In Week 8, shade sails will be installed between the church and the music area. Plants which are currently kept in the space between the Senior Block and the Presbytery will be moved into this

Those who enter through Powers Street will see a slab ready for shed construction. This shed will be the size of a 3 bay shed and will be used for general maintenance equipment storage on the carpark side. The other side will be for sporting equipment and will open onto the oval. This shed will be completed by the and of Work 9

end of Week 9. At the end of Week 10 the new classrooms under the current Year 3 classrooms will be completed. On Saturday June 18<sup>th</sup> removalists will assist the relocation process. Year 3 classes will be moved directly downstairs to occupy the new classrooms. Year 4 will then move across to occupy the classrooms currently used by Year 3.

Both Year 5 classes and 6W move across to the single storey block currently used by Year 4.
Year 6R will move into the classroom we currently use for Music lessons beside Year 2. Mrs Morley will move from class to class next term to conduct her Music

lessons. Mrs Whan will share an office with Mr Earthey and Learning Support will be conducted in the Library or in classrooms as appropriate.

This moving process will be concluded by the end of Week II when this term ends. This allows us to safely remove asbestos over the school holidays and complete the majority of the demolition of the two-storey block currently used by Years 5 and 6 over that holiday period. We then commence work on the next set of three new classrooms.

You can see that it is the end of term when most movement happens. This can't be avoided, and so it has been minimised as best we can. With our focus on relocation there will be some consequences. Report Cards won't be available until the end of Week One next term. Students in Years 3 to 6 will find disruption as we pack up to move at the end of Week 10 and during Week II. Athletics carnivals are something we all look forward to and moving them would cause further disruption so they will go ahead as planned during the last two weeks of school.

Clearly there is a lot involved, and the nature of construction is such that things can and will change. However each day we are progressing our aim to better the learning environment for our students, and we are very fortunate and grateful to be in a position to do so.
