

Principal's News

Late last week I heard Miss Zana from Prep H talking outside to a few of her children about filling buckets and the importance of being 'bucket fillers'. Intrigued, and a little concerned that I might soon have Prep children throwing buckets of water in all directions, I felt Life is not about compelled to investigate further.

Kindly Miss Zana invited me into her classroom so that her children could tell me about bucket filling. The idea is based on Carol McCloud's book, "Have you filled a Bucket Today?" It's all about doing kind acts, and learn-



ing that in helping others, you actually help yourself as well. Prep H students clearly understand this, and were working through lots of great ways of filling buckets. It's more than just a nice idea. For those of you more scientifically minded, it's worth knowing that every time you do something kind for someone else, your brain releases the chemical Oxytocin. Oxytocin leads you to feel :-

- I. An increase in self esteem /confidence
- 2. An increase in energy
- 3. An increase in your level of happiness, and
- 4. An increase in positivity.

It's feeling like these, that allow people to be resilient - to 'bounce back' so to speak when things go wrong, and it's vitally important to all of us.

It was a happy co-incidence then, that this week I have shared with staff, Parents and Friends' and Board Members a suggestion that we look at a whole of school Resilience Program for next year. Resilience can be learned, and we will be working with a group called the Resilience Project to implement a program. All those I have shared it with, are very supportive. If you'd like to know more, simply have a look at their website. I think you'll find it will be another great project parents and

school can work on together to really help our students.
