

#### **Dear Parents**

I just wanted to express my appreciation to all of those parents who responded to our Parent Satisfaction Survey last term. As I myself am not a person who loves filling in surveys, I was extremely grateful with the response rate from parents. We have 354 families at school and we received 264 parent responses. 
