PRINCIPAL'S NEWS 23 July 2021

This week we concluded enrolment interviews for Prep families new to our school. I love these interviews and I'm always grateful and humble that so many wonderful families seek enrolment in our school.

Most of you have been through the process and know that a big part of the process is the 'walk through' of our school. I want parents to have the opportunity to get a feel for our school – to see what learning looks like, to hear the interactions and to experience the culture of our school.

At the end of the walk, we talk about Religious Education, values, behavioral expectations and so on to ensure parents enrolling with us have a clear picture about Catholic Education and St Patrick's in particular.

From there it's really a discussion and a choice about whether parents feel that our school is the right fit for their family. It is essential that parents feel like they belong here and that the values they live by as a family, align with the values of St Patrick's Catholic school. People often mention that we have a family atmosphere and I'm pleased. Our school should feel a lot like home. We never want anyone to feel like they would have to change to fit in – rather that our school is a place where they will feel very welcome and very comfortable, just as they are. Like our Church, we are not a community exclusively for the perfect. Rather, we are a community who simply welcomes those who want to live their best lives and grow into the best version of themselves. We are proud to be a part of Catholic Education, and look forward to celebrating Catholic Education Week.




