A Spanish man, Ivan Fernandez, was right behind him and realizing what was going on, started shouting to the Kenyan to keep running. Mutai did not know Spanish and did not understand.

Realizing what was going on, Fernandez pushed Mutai to victory.

A reporter asked Ivan, "Why did you do this?" Ivan replied, "My dream is that one day we can have some sort of community life where we push ourselves and also others to win".

The reporter insisted "But why did you let the Kenyan win?" Ivan replied "I didn't let him win, he was going to win. The race was his".

The reporter insisted and asked again, "But what would be the merit of my victory? What would be the honor of this medal? What would my mother think of it?"

I love Ivan's last question, "What would my mother think of it?" As parents, most of us have had the experience of hearing ourselves speak to our children using the same words our parents spoke to us. It's not new, nor surprising to learn, that values are transmitted from one generation to the next.

As parents and educators, we are privileged to be able to speak to and influence the future, through the next generation. It serves to make us very aware of how we should conduct ourselves, so that the values we pass on as parents and teachers are values we are proud of. On occasions when we need to redirect children, I do ask how their parents will feel when they hear of their behaviour. It becomes very clear to both of us, how closely home and school aligns. It makes a huge difference, and I am always appreciative of it.

School Fee Assistance


