The staff and parents here are amazing. Our Mothers' Day liturgy was special and we had hundreds of parents go well out of their way to make the time to celebrate with us. There was effort on behalf of our parents, and there was also the effort from the staff who prepared the liturgy, slotted together hundreds of photos, put out hundreds of chairs, set up the PA system and prepared and practised with their children so that they would lead the service well.

At lunch time we had staff and parents cut up, cook, serve and clean up after the sausage sizzle that gives parents a break and raises money for charities every Friday.

On Friday and through to Saturday lunch time we had staff offer a Music Camp to the 38 students from Years Four to Six learned so much and who worked and behaved so well. In their own time, staff supervised the students through the night and we had two parents assisting and supporting us.

We see similar commitments with our sporting teams, musical students and in the day to day interactions at our school. Sometimes we forget how lucky we are here. It is very special.

At Mass on Sunday – Fr John Daley used the Gospel readings, and Mothers' day, to focus on love. One quote he used which I particularly liked went along the lines of, "The love that Jesus asks us to show is too hard – and yet, there is no other way."

## **FINANCE NEWS**

#### **School Fees**

A reminder that school fees are <u>DUE</u> payable <u>TODAY</u> unless you have a payment plan in place in which case this merely serves as a statement of account. Upon receipt, please take time to review your invoice/statement and contact Finance Secretary Maria Davies if you have any queries. Please check your junk box if you haven't received your statement and contact the office to request a copy.

#### School Fee Assistance

Families may be eligible for school fee assistance under the Concession Card Tuition Fee Discount and /or the Principals' Concession Scheme.

#### Government Concession Card Fee Discount

A 70% Tuition Fee Discount is available for 'means tested' government Health Care and Pensioner Concession cards. The Concession Card information and FAQs are available on the Catholic Education website. These cards must meet eligibility criteria for this concession to apply and must be presented to the Finance Officer.

#### Principal's Concession Scheme

Total or partial exemption from the payment of fees and levies is available on application to the Principal based on individual basis and circumstances. If required, contact the Finance Officer to discuss your circumstances and make an appointment to meet with the Principal.




