## CHANGES FOR 2019

As a part of our annual review and school improvement processes, we've had a look at how well we are using our learning time. Two areas were clearly identified in Swimming and Class Assemblies.

At the moment, the amount of time we devote to swimming, is disproportionate to the benefit. With the time it takes to prepare 75 children at a time for swimming, travel to the venue by bus, move the children into their groups, return to school and change, we are spending between two and three hours of core learning time for well less than an hour in the pool. If we want children to be safe and proficient at swimming, five lessons in large groups will do very little to progress them. They really need to go every week, and many families from our school already do this. We believe we must do better with our time, and so swimming lessons in their current format won't continue in 2019. We will however look to include some aquatic activities, including a modified swimming carnival for Years 3-6 as the year progresses.

Next year, we will continue with Courtyard Prayer, class liturgies, whole-school liturgies and major assemblies, ensuring our children get plenty of opportunities to develop confidence in their public speaking. We will however not continue with class assemblies. Once again, the time it takes from core learning for a class to prepare an Assembly, coupled with taking 500 children away from their learning to be an audience, doesn't measure up when we consider the time and effort involved in relation to the benefit to students.

We are always looking at ways of improving our school, and decisions like these are never made without consultation and careful consideration. Making sure we spend learning time well will always remain a focus for our school, and we are looking forward to improvements in this area next year.

#### FEES


