This week we had Year 6M lead us in Courtyard Prayer for what would seem the last time before they venture out, beyond the gates of St Patrick's. I walked away each morning inspired by their message 'in a world where you can be anything, be kind'. They then shared one of my favourite songs, 'Go Make a Difference'. It was very fitting and made me wonder where this group of young people would take us in to the future. How would they continue to 'make a difference'? This must be a consideration for all, as our future depends on positively charged, ethically driven, global citizens.

This week we also held a special gathering of School and Parish Leaders to discuss how we can work to strengthen our connections, into our future. We discussed 'Alpha' which is a new faith discovery program which has been embraced by our parish and interested members of our community. It originally begun in London 30 years ago. It is now in 169 countries throughout the world and has been experienced by 29 million guests. Alpha creates a space where our friends, family, neighbours can explore the Christian faith and the meaning of life in a way that is relaxed and respectful. The first one will be held on **Thursday**, 5th **October**, in the **Waterford Building**, **Shalom College**, beginning at 5.30pm. All are welcome. You don't need to have any faith affiliation to attend. It is perfectly placed for those who were baptised Catholic, but may have lost touch with their church over time or those wishing to make new connections. This week marks Child Safety Week and our Leadership Team, Counsellor and OHSC Co-ordinator attended two days of Professional Development around this theme. The sessions began with a focus on Matthew 19:14 "Let the little children come to me, and do not hinder them". It is no secret that our Director, Leesa Jeffcoat, is extremely passionate about the safety for all young people in our care and this filters strongly, throughout our Diocese. We listened to research and leaders in this field. The theme for Child Safety Week is 'Where We Start Matters' and this triggered for me how we carry a dual responsibility to support young people and must work to be trauma informed practitioners, charged with the task to create a calm, safe space for students. Not an easy task but a most important shared goal.

Next week, I look forward to venturing off to Hervey Bay and K'gari with our Year 6 teachers and students. If the glorious weather experienced this week continues, we are certainly in for a treat.

SMOKING AND VAPING LAWS

Queensland Health has advised that new smoke and vape-free public places come into effect from 1 September 2023. Smoking and vaping are already prohibited at public and private school facilities and in a 5-metre buffer zone extending from the boundary of the school.

Further to our current practices, the new laws apply to school carparks and are intended to complement the existing bans that apply across and around school campuses. *The new law extends the smoke and vape-free protection to include all carparks provided for school communities.*

The laws apply to all persons using a school carpark including students, teaching staff, parents and guardians of students, other employees of the school, visitors and persons providing a service or volunteering, clubs and organisations accessing school facilities.


